Why awareness seminars?

Since cross-border cooperation programmes among Western Balkan countries will be implemented for the first time under the new financial instrument of the EU – IPA (Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance), it is of key importance that all potential final beneficiaries of the programmes are informed well in advance on both IPA itself and the content of the programmes: eligible areas, priorities, measures and financial allocations as well.

Montenegro participates in four IPA CBC programmes with neighbouring Western Balkan countries (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia and Serbia). The seminars are organized by CBIB and the Secretariat for European Integration (SEI) of the Government of Montenegro.

Who is invited to the seminars?

All the potential applicants under IPA CBC programmes from the territory of the municipalities of **Žabljak, Plužine, Šavnik, Nikšić, Podgorica, Danilovgrad**:

- government institutions,
- local/regional authorities,
- government or non-profit education institutions,
- universities and research institutions,
- NGOs,
- professional associations,
- chambers of commerce,
- public utility companies,
- small and medium enterprises.

What can you learn at the seminars?

The objective of the seminar is to present you with information about:

- all four cross-border programmes with neighbouring Western Balkan countries in the framework of IPA that Montenegro participates in;
- transnational programmes (South-East European Space and MED) that Montenegro will also take part in;
- Cross Border Institution Building project and its activities;
- cross-border projects;
- next steps – training for potential applicants and partner search.
