### Natural market (or catchment area)

 Fewer job opportunities for individuals

 Smaller pool of skills for employers





### **Cross-border obstacles impact**

### Removing only **ONE fifth** of all obstacles could lead to:



 Loss of potential in terms of socioeconomic development

 "Border Effect" = Unmet potential development in terms of:

Labour mobility

Employment opportunities

Enhanced pool of skills for employers

Balancing contiguous labour markets

Economic growth

### **HISTEK goals**

To connect the world of Education and the world of Business at Cross-border level.

To co-design a new level 5 of Cross-border qualification (based on the European Qualifications Framework (EQF)) training offers for specialised technicians:

aligned with the real needs of Cross-Border SMEs,

And focusing on common standards on advanced technologies, as one of the cornerstones for technological development of companies, in particular for SMEs

• To favor the Cross-border Mobility of young people, making internationalization and innovation processes more sustainable for CB SMEs.



### **Example of activity - Analysis of the training offer in the 3 countries**

- Focus of the analysis on:
  - Advanced Manufacturing Technologies (KET 6), considered by the European Commission as one of the cornerstones of the technological development strategies of companies, especially SMEs.

#### Cross-Border Aspects explored:

- **Context:** Materials and resources (equipment, laboratories, classrooms..).
- Professional resources: Skills possessed by teachers, with specific focus on KET 6.
- **Relations with the territory:** existing links between education and business.
- Training offers, including transversal skills and technical skills linked to Advanced Manufacturing.



### **Example of activity - Analysis of the training offer in the 3 countries**

#### Targets involved:

**Puglia:** 10 Schools in the Technological field belonging to 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Levels EQF.

 Albania: 10 Schools in the Technological field belonging to

4<sup>th</sup>–5<sup>th</sup> levels EQF.

 Montenegro: 48 Schools in the Technological field belonging to 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Levels EQF.









### **HISTEK+** Capitalisation Actions

- Actions to raise the awareness of the 3 Ministries about the opportunity to setup the new Cross-Border 5<sup>th</sup> level EQF curriculum, with common standards and with a final recognition system, valid in the three countries.
- Actions to enlarge the HISTEK Cluster, composed by IT-AL-ME SMEs/Educational Institutions/Public Institutions, for supporting the implementation of the HISTEK Model, favoring the creation of a strong Cross-Border educational system aimed at boosting the real and sustainable competitiveness of Cross-Border SMEs.



### 4 EUSAIR under revision



### **EUSAIR today**



 10 countries: 4 EU MSs (GR, HR, SI, IT - 13 regions) + 5 IPA countries (AL, BiH, ME, RS, MK) + San Marino



- 72 million inhabitants.
- GDP (PPS) is 10% of that of the EU27.





### IPA Advion & EUSAIR MRS facilitating the Electron Endergy of the Western Balkan

- A convergence of interests on the enlargement between EU member and IPA countries;
- A regional dimension that reconnects the WB to the EU;
- A horizontal cooperation based on equal footing;
- A capacity building effect;
- An emphasis on the relevance of territorial cooperation and cohesion and the 4 key dimension towards the EU Green Deal Actions for 2050
- An inclusive approach towards stakeholders with participatory processes (consultation, engagement and mobilisation).



### **EUSAIR expected achievements and value**

#### **Key Achievements**

- Increase in cooperation capacity (generation of joint actions/policy)
- Increase in dialogue
- Bringing actors together
  - Across countries and sectors
  - Across levels comes with maturity (time) and capacity
- Cooperation with the EC is a sign of maturity.

#### Added-value

- Cooperation brings legitimacy to the work key added value.
- Working with issue on a transnational basis can increase awareness and attention (nationally).
- Facilitate synergies across sectors (closely linked with policy dialogue).
